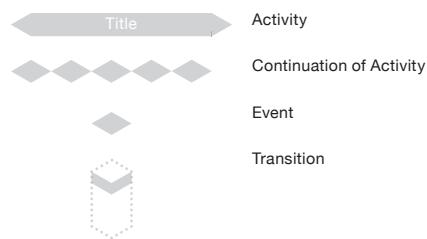

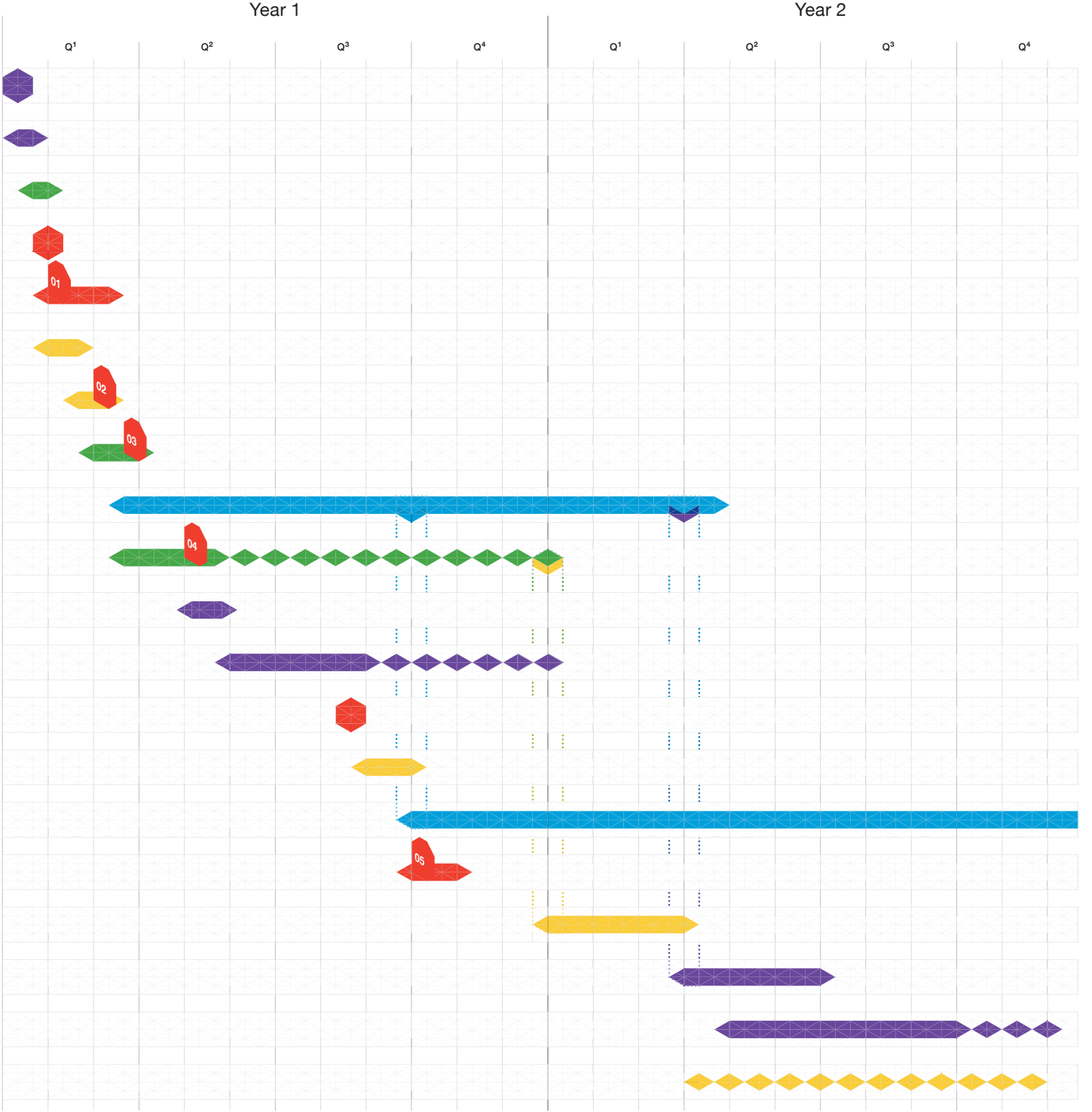

Revit® Template File

The REVIT template is the key tool for effective kick off, maximising productivity & ensuring consistency.

02

Template / Project Start Up Guide

The template guide ensures team members understand and enjoy the benefits of the full range of attributes built into the template file. It also forms a useful guideline for consistent project start up.

Project Briefing Doc

The pattern for the drawdown of information for teams engaging in a BIM process varies from that familiar in 2D traditional work flows significantly. In essence the team needs to know more, sooner. The D4 form assists in drawing out the salient factors and distributes them widely to the team in an accessibly simple manner.

Company BEP

Every office engaging in BIM projects requiring a Level 2 BIM standard require a BIM execution plan in place. In any case no one should embark on such a project without it. Offices can adopt and adapt the excellent AEC UK standard example, borrow from one of the many available on line or develop their own with the assistance of the Deploi team.

Company BIM Protocol

Ultimately each company will wish to codify their BIM policy, standards and resources for the use of all members of their team. The best examples of this type of document will form a graphic manual and CAD standard, a technology guide as well as a project management and policy document. This is a highly tailored and sensitive form of documentation which will have significant relevance to the office at the strategic as well as production level.

Smartblocks

D9 Smartbloks is a process developed by Deploi to facilitate fast, accurate and responsive residential sector feasibility studies, though it may be applied to any repetitive typology. E.g. Hotels, Student accommodation etc. The process comprises a set of specially built Revit "families", Schedules and Parameters which combined fill the gap between Revits standard concept modelling and full building modelling. It handles the tracking of differences such as tenure and accessibility as well as unit types. This powerful tool can cut initial feasibility study times while increasing accuracy, reducing subsequent reactive design change times even further.
